Bhudevi (Andal) Abhishekam

Abhishekam is a sanskrit word for the celestial bath that is performed to the deity. All bedecked gold and diamond ornaments, clothing, and finery is taken off from the deity except a white loin. The abhishekam is performed by priests with water, milk, curd, ghee, coconut water, honey, turmeric, sandal paste etc.

Sri Maha Manyu Suktha Anjaneya Garuda Aparajitha Homam

Manyu Suktha, *Garuda*, and *Aparajitha* mantras are the most powerful mantras as per our scriptures. These mantras are recited for Anjaneya, Garuda Alwar, and Aparajitha with the inner presence (Antaryami) as Sriman Narayana.

As many devotees are struggling with external enemies such as health, wisdom, delays in marriage, continuation of family (vamsabhi vrudhi), and internal foes as lust (kama), anger (krodha), greed (lobha), attachment of negative kind (moha), arrogance to be differentiated from ego (mada), and jealousy (maatsarya). By doing this homam we can try to relieve these external enemies from our lives and have some peace at heart.
