### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- 3.2 GPA or higher

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

A committee appointed by the SVTCC will assess applications and award the scholarships to students with the highest scores as per the following scoring guide:

Academic Standing (GPA)	20 points
Application Accuracy	5 points
Total Possible Points	100 points

- 6. Scholarships will be awarded to the selected recipients in May 2024.
